• OFFSHORE SERVICES AT SEA CLIFF YACHT CLUB•

Anchorage:

A limited number of guest moorings will be available during the Regatta however the SCYC launch will service boats that anchor adjacent to the mooring field. After finishing hail the SCYC launch on Channel 9 for directions to an available mooring or suitable anchorage area. Reservations can be made for guest moorings prior to Friday and after Sunday (of the Regatta weekend). Call the SCYC office at 516-671-7374 to make reservations. Reservations will be accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis.

Launch Services:

The SCYC launch monitors VHF channel 9. Twenty-four-hour launch service will be provided to competitors during peak finishing times. See the schedule posted on the dockhouse for hours of launch service

for the week following the regatta. The SCYC launch does also respond to three (3) blasts of an air horn.

SCYC Dock:

SCYC dock may be used for loading and unloading only. A maximum of fifteen minutes tied to the dock is requested. A fresh water hose and pump out station is available. Approach dock from the channel direct on, at least half tide or higher.

Overnight Dockage:

Available at local marinas by reservation. The marinas are located east of SCYC on Glen Cove Creek (in order of proximity to SCYC). All are within walking distance of SCYC.

Brewer's Yacht Yard: (516) 671-5563

Mechanic, ice, fuel, water, showers, marine supplies. No fuel sales, overnight dockage. Reservations are recommended.

Glen Cove Marina: (516) 759-3129

Mechanic, water, fuel, (gas, diesel), riggers if needed, overnight dockage. Call first.

Regatta Desk:

Located in the Regatta Room (downstairs) of SCYC this is "Cablevision ALIR Central". Staffed around the clock beginning 0900 hours on Friday; yacht positions and finishing times will be posted as information is received. This is the place to contact during the race for all information, problems or questions of local knowledge.

From Thursday through Sunday during the CABLEVISION ALIR, the number for information regarding the race is (516) 674-4320 (Regatta Desk). **PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE SCYC OFFICE. Instead, call the Regatta Desk.** A pay phone for outgoing calls is at beach level, near the stairway and in the coat room of the club house.

Message Center:

There will be a bulletin board at the Regatta Desk for messages received for you. To leave a message call 516-674-4320. Check at the Regatta Desk upon arrival at the Club for your messages.

VHF Radio:

CABLEVISION ALIR Race Committee will monitor Channel 72.

Bar & Food Services:

The Regatta Room bar on the lower level and/or our main level bar and restaurant on the upper deck will be opened for extended hours during the regatta. In addition to regular SCYC hours, we have many volunteers who are ready to welcome you to the Club. The Clubhouse will be open while the Regatta Desk is in operation.

Payment of Services:

Food and drink purchases will be paid in scrip. Several tables will be set up to accommodate your cash purchases of the scrip. PLEASE NOTE - As nearly 1,000 people pass through the Club during this regatta, it would be a bookkeeping nightmare to handle these purchases any other way. Also, the scrip cannot be used or redeemed by any SCYC member or employee.

Swimming & Showers:

Our beach, swimming pool and showers are open to all our CABLEVISION ALIR guests. Bring your own towels, etc.

Shirt & Hat Sales:

CABLEVISION ALIR shirts & hats will be sold throughout the regatta at the Regatta Desk.

Parking:

There are no parking spaces available in the SCYC parking lot. All spaces are privately owned. The parking lot is restricted to drop off and pick up only. There is parking on the streets in the area. However, watch out for low fire hydrants & driveways, as this is a residential area. You may have to drive around the block for a space. If you wish to leave a car overnight look for the special "overnight" parking areas.

Local Services:

Check with Regatta Desk Volunteers or Club members for information regarding train schedules, taxis, supplies, restaurants, drugstores, etc. All stores are located "up the hill".

Post Race Party:

The Awards Celebration Party will begin at 1500 hours on Sunday, August 1, 1999. at SCYC. Plan to spend the afternoon celebrating the Cablevision ALIR with live music and \$1 beer, wine and rum drinks.

Refuse Disposal:

The Village of Sea Cliff enforces extremely strict recycling rules. Under threat of heavy fines and possible loss of our removal services if these rules are not adhered to, we must ask that trash removed from your boat for disposal in Sea Cliff in clear garbage bags and sorted into:

Recyclable cans and bottles

Non-recyclable cans, bottles & glass

All other trash.

SCYC launch operators and staff have been told not to permit any other garbage bags on the premises. We appreciate your support and cooperation in complying with these regulations. Thank You.
